

17 June 2018 (Third Sunday after Trinity)

Welcome to all worshippers this evening to Christ the Saviour Presbyterian Fellowship in Krakow. As you enter the sanctuary, please feel free to greet one another. When the prelude begins let us quietly prepare for the worship of God. If you are worshipping with us for the first time, please allow us to get to know you better by staying for tea and coffee after the service.

REFLECTION BEFORE THE SERVICE (silence is kept)

HYMN - Be still my soul (see the red hymnal)

RESPONSIVE READING:

Celebrant: Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD, O my soul!

All: I will praise the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praises to my God while I have my being.

Celebrant: Put not your trust in princes, in a son of man, in whom there is no salvation. When his breath departs, he returns to the earth; on that very day his plans perish.

All: Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD his God,

Celebrant: who made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, who keeps faith forever;

All: who executes justice for the oppressed, who gives food to the hungry. The LORD sets the prisoners free; Celebrant: the LORD opens the eyes of the blind. The LORD lifts up those who are bowed down; the LORD loves the righteous. The LORD watches over the sojourners; he upholds the widow and the fatherless, but the way of the wicked he brings to ruin.

All: The LORD will reign forever, your God, O Zion, to all generations. Praise the LORD!
