#### CONFESSION OF SINS

*A moment of silence is followed by this corporate prayer:*

**Celebrant:** Merciful God, you pardon all who truly repent and turn to you. We humbly confess our sins and ask your mercy. We have not loved you with a pure heart, nor have we loved our neighbor as ourselves. We have not done justice, loved kindness, or walked humbly with you, our God. Have mercy on us, O God, in your loving-kindness. In your great compassion, cleanse us from our sin.

**All: Create in us a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within us. Do not cast us from your presence, or take your Holy Spirit from us. Restore to us the joy of your salvation and sustain us with your bountiful Spirit through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen. — based on Psalm 51:10-12**

#### RESPONSIVE READING

**Celebrant:** Hear my prayer, O LORD; let my cry for help come before You.

**All: Do not hide Your face from me in the day of my distress. Incline Your ear to me; answer me quickly when I call.**

**Celebrant:** For my days vanish like smoke, and my bones burn like glowing embers.

**All: My heart is afflicted, and withered like grass; I even forget to eat my bread.**

**Celebrant:** Through my loud groaning, my flesh clings to my bones. I am like a desert owl, like an owl among the ruins. I lie awake;

**All: I am like a lone bird on a housetop.**

**Celebrant:** All day long my enemies taunt me; they ridicule and curse me. For I have eaten ashes like bread and mixed my drink with tears, because of Your indignation and wrath; for You have picked me up and cast me aside.

**All: My days are like lengthening shadows, and I wither away like grass.**

**Celebrant:** But You, O LORD, sit enthroned forever; Your renown endures to all generations.

**All: You will rise up and have compassion on Zion, for it is time to show her favor— the appointed time has come.**

**Celebrant:** For Your servants delight in her stones and take pity on her dust.
