### Reflection before the service

#### CONFESSION OF SINS

*A moment of silence is followed by this corporate prayer:*

We have offended against your holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; and we have done those things which we ought not to have done. O Lord, have mercy upon us. Spare those who confess their faults. Restore those who are penitent, according to your promises declared to the world in Christ Jesus, our Lord. And grant, O merciful God, for his sake, that we may live a holy, just, and humble life to the glory of your holy name. Amen.**

#### RESPONSIVE READING

**Celebrant:** God shall arise, his enemies shall be scattered; and those who hate him shall flee before him!
